6 The Physical

The doctor learns not to take anything for granted in this short exchange between doctor and patient.

Most people have a pretty good idea of what a doctor's office looks like, but you might have some fun by choosing either an examining room or consultation room for your set. To suggest an examining room, drape a long table with a sheet and have the patient on his back for the "action." For a consultation room, simply make a large name plate "Dr. So-and-So" for a table or desk, with a nearby chair for the patient. In either event, the Doctor might borrow a stethoscope and white jacket. If the scene is an examining room, a not-too-shy patient might remove his shirt.
